



## **QA: Why Are Some Never Satisfied with Justice?** by [John T Polk II](#)

**QUESTION: Why do some people keep demanding "justice" and never seem to be satisfied?**

**ANSWER: It seems very few are able to receive true "justice."**

1. **"Justice" (a.k.a. "judgment") is the standard of fair and balanced decision in matters of judgment.**

a. ***Under Moses:***

You shall appoint judges and officers in all your gates, which the LORD your God gives you, according to your tribes, and they shall judge the people with just judgment. You shall not pervert justice; you shall not show partiality, nor take a bribe, for a bribe blinds the eyes of the wise and twists the words of the righteous. You shall follow what is altogether just, that you may live and inherit the land which the LORD your God is giving you. (**Deuteronomy 16:18-20**)

ALL JUDGMENTS (IN OR OUT OF COURTS) TAINTED BY PREJUDICE, OR PERSONAL ADVANTAGE, ARE CONDEMNED BY GOD'S "JUSTICE!" All "justice" should be accompanied by, "The fear of the LORD [which, jtpll] is the beginning of wisdom" (**Proverbs 9:10**). "The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether" (**Psalms 19:9**). Ungodly judges give ungodly judgments.

b. ***Under Christ:***

"Judge not, that you be not judged. For with what judgment you judge, you will be judged; and with the measure you use, it will be measured back to you." (**Matthew 7:1-2**)

Jesus offers "justice" when He said:

"I can of Myself do nothing. As I hear, I judge; and My judgment is righteous, because I do not seek My own will but the will of the Father who sent Me." (**John 5:30**)

He commands Christians to: "Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment" (**John 7:24**).

**GOD NEVER FORBIDS "JUDGING"/ "JUSTICE" AS LONG AS IT IS BALANCED WITH HIS LAW! Every "Justice Department" Should Be Influenced By, Or Based Upon, God's Word To Be "Just."**

2. **"Justice" is often used as a political slogan to badger the opposition into submission.** Then "justice" never seems to be achieved because the group calling for "justice" have not reached their real goal. Those who brand everyone else as "racist" and opposition as "oppressors" will never claim "justice" has been reached until they, are completely in charge and have re written all the laws to their own advantage. When Paul preached the Gospel in Antioch of Pisidia,

The Jews stirred up the devout and prominent women and the chief men of the city, raised up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region. (**Acts 13:49-50**)

It's easy to stir up people, even devout people, by mis representing facts. Jews "opposed the things spoken by Paul," a.k.a. The Gospel of Christ! "Cancel culture" reared its ugly head even then!

3. **False teachers are guilty of "evil suspicions" (1 Timothy 6:4)**, which spreads like a plague! Those who constantly call for "justice" should know what that is, and accept it when it is offered, and not label it as "injustice." When they reject true "justice," they are admitting their ignorance of the subject!
