Have you ever wondered why so little sediment exists on the seafloor? Every year, wind and water erode dirt off the continents, and it runs off into the oceans. Most of this dirt, or sediment, stays near the continents. Scientists know how much dirt comes off the continents each year, about 20 billion tons. What is the average thickness of sediment all over the seafloor? Not even 1,300 feet. When we do the math, the amount of dirt piled up at the bottom of the world's oceans can be accounted for in far less time than the billions of years evolutionists claim for Earth's history. If the oceans were truly billions of years old, there should be vastly more sediment at the bottom of the oceans.

At the same time, above ground we find enormous sedimentary rock layers covering huge portions of the continents. Entire regions are stacked with layers of sandstone, shale, limestone, and mudstone filled with fossils and water-deposited material. So where did so much of the sediment go? From a biblical Flood perspective, the answer is that much of the sediment did not remain as loose mud sitting on the seafloor. During Noah's Flood, massive amounts of sediment were rapidly deposited, compacted, and hardened into the rock layers we now see exposed across the Earth. Later uplift and erosion revealed these layers above ground.

The lack of massive loose sediment piles on the seafloor, combined with the enormous sedimentary rock layers spread across the continents, fits far better with catastrophic Flood geology than with slow accumulation over endless ages.

One final thought: even "millions of years worth" of sediment based on today's accumulation rates would not prove the oceans are millions of years old. That calculation assumes today's slow processes have always operated at the same rate. During Noah's Flood only thousands of years ago, sediment would have been moving into the oceans at rates far beyond anything we observe today as the fountains of the great deep broke open and catastrophic waters reshaped the Earth.

THE SEA FLOOR

The ocean floor is mostly flat and covered by sediment deposited during the global Flood.

ROCK LAYERS FROM THE FLOOD

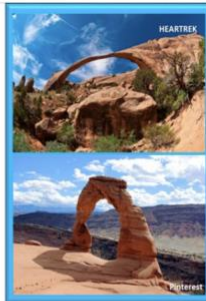
These rock layers were laid down rapidly during the global Flood. Different layers formed in different conditions as the Flood waters moved and receded.

These layers were formed in days to months during the catastrophic global Flood described in the Bible, not over millions or billions of years.

Arches defy secular geologies millions of years. The Biblical flood provides a much better explanation of the evidence.

Geological expert Michael Oard, in a paper on Arches National Park said that despite there being over 2,000 arches in Arches National Park, 43 collapsed between 1970 and 2022. Given the prevailing erosion rate from wind and rain, it is certain that all the arches will disappear in about 2,000 years. The idea that they are millions of years old lacks credibility. Today, rock arches form only with the assistance of water pressure, which is absent in the park, and there is no other plausible explanation for their formation in secular uniformitarian geology. The only reasonable explanation is a recent catastrophic Genesis flood that occurred only a few thousand years ago.
