

**The purpose of Jesus' miracles was to establish identity, NOT to** continue to provide escape from sickness and death! **John 20:30-31**  
*There are only 7 miracles specifically mentioned before His resurrection.*  
 This selectivity shows that miracles do NOT need to be repeated or continued forever in order to produce complete faith in Jesus as God's Son.
