[God Is Plaintive]

During Jerusalem's Downfall 2 Kings 23-25; 2 Chronicles 36

Blueprint For Redemption

- I. Lament over Jerusalem's Destruction 1:1-22 Redemption
- II. Lament over Judah's Debasement 2:1-22
- III. Lament over Jeremiah's Demeaning 3:1-66
- IV. Lament over Jerusalem's Degeneracy 4:1-22
- V. Lament over Judah's Dishonor 5:1-22

Digging In The Dirge:

1. Hebrew Poetic Style:

Chap. 1-2 (22 verses @); Chap. 3; Chap. 4-5 (22 verses @)

- 2. **Jeremiah** wept over *Jerusalem's destruction*; **Jesus** wept over *Jerusalem's destruction* in AD 70 (**Matthew 23:34-39**; **Luke 13:31-35**; **19:41-44**)
- 3. Jerusalem:
- Was as lonely as a widow 1:1
- "Did not consider her destiny" 1:9
- Let "nations enter her sanctuary" whom God forbade 1:10
- Had no one to care 1:12
- Had abandoned the law and the prophets 2:9
- Had eaten her children and murdered priest and prophet 2:20; 4:10
- Forgot prosperity for the pain 3:17
- Was spared a bit through the LORD's mercies 3:22, 31
- Showed less nurturing than jackals 4:3
- Squandered away their inheritance 5:2
- Had to buy water and firewood 5:4
- Lost all joy 5:15
- Too late for tears 1:16; 2:11; 3:49
- Too late for repentance 3:40
- There is NO true prophecy without the Lord 3:37
- This punishment was greater than that of Sodom 4:6
- There is a "better way to die" than slowly 4:9
- Drunkenness is associated with nakedness 4:21
