Jesus Christ said,

"And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself." This He said, signifying by what death He would die. (John 12:32-33)

[He] by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. (**Hebrews 2:9**)

- 1) Perverted. But there are "ungodly men, who turn the grace of our God into lewdness and deny the only Lord God and our Lord Jesus Christ" (Jude 1:4).
- 2) Ridiculed. Paul wrote:

For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. (1 Corinthians 1:18)

Jesus said: "He who believes and is baptized will be saved." (Mark 16:16)

**Each Death** 

And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment. (**Hebrews 9:27**)

We all have an appointment with death. David seems to list the ways a man can die:

The LORD shall strike him, or his day shall come to die, or he shall go out to battle and perish. (1 Samuel 26:10)

Death can come by God's stroke, natural causes, or war. Jesus Christ was subjected to the same:

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil. (**Hebrews 2:14**)

The Devil makes God's appointment as tragic, painful, or agonizingly slow as possible, to destroy the faith of the victim or family. Jesus came to help with hope: let Him!
