MOSES REQUIRED MORE THAN "SACRIFICES"

Leviticus 23:37 - 38

“These are the feasts of the LORD which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day — the Sabbaths of the LORD, besides your gifts, besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill offerings which you give to the LORD.”

2. *Sunday night and Wednesday night are needed. “JUDGMENT”*
3. *NOT GRUDGINGLY: “Obey those who rule over you, and be submissive, for they watch out for your souls, as those who must give account. Let them do so with joy and not with grief, for that would be unprofitable for you.” Hebrews 13:17 “FREEWILL”*
