- C. He did not learn the Gospel from the other Apostles.
 - a) Galatians 1:11-12, 16-17
 - b) 1 Corinthians 15:7-10
 - c) 2 Corinthians 11:5; 12:11-12

2. God's Prophets in the Holy Scriptures 1:2-4

A. Jesus Christ is the ONLY Prophet promised of God!



Deuteronomy 18:15-19

- a) Written centuries before
- b) NOT "oral traditions" or "superstitions"

#2 2. God's Prophets in the Holy Scriptures 1:2-4

B. He is the ONLY Prophet God provided!

- a) Specific, through David, NOT Mohammed
- b) Specified by His resurrection from the dead

a) A consistent theme Romans 16:26

b) For all nations

3. The Salvation He Offers 1:5-7

- b) "Saints" in Rome long before there was a Roman Catholic Church!
 - c) NOT ONCE did Paul address Peter in Rome!

#2 Answering the "call" makes one "a saint"

The "Called" 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14:

"But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, 14 to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ."

#3 Answering the "call" makes one "a saint"

The "Calling" 2 Timothy 1:8-9: "share with me in the sufferings for the gospel according to the power of God, 9 who has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began,"

God has approved Jesus Christ as THE Prophet

John 6:14: "Then those men, when they had seen the sign that Jesus did, said, 'This is truly the Prophet who is to come into the world."

Have YOU approved Jesus Christ as YOUR Prophet?

Matthew 21:11: "So the multitudes said, 'This is Jesus, the prophet from Nazareth of Galilee."
