# What “Victory?”

1. “For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world--our faith. Who is he who overcomes the world, but he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?” **(1 John 5:4-5)**
2. The Resurrection of all for Judgment is the time the “righteous” will be rewarded. **Galatians 6:7-8**

- 1. “Steadfast” = “be seated”**
- 2. “Immovable” = “not moving away”**
- 3. “Always abounding in the work of the Lord”**
  - a. continually developing**
  - b. “the work of the Lord”**
