David wrote this after he was spared from Achish, king of Gath (1 Samuel 21:13-15). Persecutions Paul endured, because:

... Out of them all the Lord delivered me (2 Timothy 3:11).

When Jesus was crucified, and the soldiers:

... came to Jesus and saw that He was already dead, they did not break His legs" (John 19:33),

then Psalm 34:20 proved true! Also true is that people doing evil "hate the righteous," and "all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will suffer persecution" (2 Timothy 3:12). God delivers, not from suffering, but forever!
