4-18-2016 Salvation and Worship

So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read (Luke 4:16).

Jesus began His public preaching in a Jewish synagogue. A "synagogue" was a local Jewish worship place. "Custom" is what He was brought up doing: going to "church!" People who obey the Gospel will worship with the saved. The people were told to:

Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). [3000] gladly received his word were baptized (Acts 2:41).

That church of Christ:

... Continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers (Acts 2:41-42).

Salvation will bring one into church worship.

In the New Testament, there is no record of a sinner being saved by prayer alone. When the church of Christ began, sinful Jews asked, "what shall we do?" Peter told them:

Repent and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38).

The first Gentile sinner, Cornelius, was praying, but was told to send for Peter to tell him saving words (Acts 10:30; 11:14).

[Peter] commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord (Acts 10:48).

Saul of Tarsus saw Jesus, Who sent him into Damascus where he prayed, and was told to:

Be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the name of the Lord (Acts 22:16).

None of them were told to pray, claim their salvation, or join the church of their choice.
