8-8-2016 Miracles and Faith

In **John 9:1-11**, Jesus miraculously gave sight to a man who had been born blind. That man said,

Since the world began it has been unheard of that anyone opened the eyes of one who was born blind. If this Man were not from God, He could do nothing (John 9:32-33).

When Jesus' friend, Lazarus, died,

[some of] The Jews said, 'Could not this Man, who opened the eyes of the blind also have kept this man from dying?' (John 11:37).

Many people seem to think, if Jesus is the Christ, He would miraculously heal everyone, and no one would die! Miracles stand out because they were not normal, so as to prove Jesus was:

... A Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst (Acts 2:22).

Bible miracles produce faith, not an eternal "tree of life."

8-9 and 10-2016 Miracles and Apostles

And through the hands of the apostles many signs and wonders were done among the people (Acts 5:12).

Apostolic "miracles" were demonstrations of God's Power above and beyond all "natural" happenings. They confirmed, in a public way, that God was speaking through these men.

Beloved, I now write to you this second epistle (in both of which I stir up your pure minds by way of reminder), that you may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the

commandment of us, the apostles of the Lord and Savior (2 Peter 3:1-2).

This "great a salvation" "at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him" (**Hebrews 2:3**). Jesus said:

"He who believes and is baptized will be saved" (Mark 16:16).

Contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints (**Jude 1:3**).
