But the boat was now in the middle of the sea, tossed by the waves, for the wind was contrary. Now in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went to them,

walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw Him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, 'It is a ghost!' And they cried out for fear. But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid' (Matthew 14:24-27).

They were afraid when they thought they were dealing with a "ghost," or out-of-body being, but were mistaken. Faith in Jesus Christ overcomes fear.

But the angel answered and said to the women, 'Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay' (Matthew 28:5-6).

An "angel of the Lord" opened Jesus' tomb on the first day of the week. When the women came to His tomb, it was opened, and the angel had to say, "Do not be afraid." Death is so final, people are afraid to think a body has escaped its tomb. There is a difference in make-believe "Zombies," and a resurrected body. Jesus was no "Zombie," for "He is risen," that is, His is body lived again. The thought of make-believe "Zombies" creates fear, the actual fact of Jesus' resurrection creates faith! "Do not be afraid."
