

## Should States Pass Laws To Say "You Can't Say 'Gay'?" by John T Polk II

OUESTION: "Should States pass laws that say 'you can't say "gay""?"

ANSWER: States can pass whatever laws they wish, but whether or not they are contradicting God's Word is another matter, indeed. Any Government's "laws" do nothing to change or alter God's Law, which is always unchanged.

Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven. (Psalm 119:89)

"But the word of the LORD endures forever." Now this is the word which by the gospel was preached to you. (1 Peter 1:25)

- 1) No law proposed says "you can't say 'gay'" but rather, Florida is working on one that uses the expressions "gender identity" and "sexual orientation" twice each. It is designed to turn back over to parents the authority to regulate sexual training their children receive in schools. Only the "Alphabet Community" (i.e. LGBTQ) misrepresents and opposes such Bills because they have tried to force their life style on everyone else! Teaching "gayness" in schools has little to do with "acceptance" of the term, and everything to to with "recruitment" to their concept!
- 2) God's Creation cannot question their "creation."

But indeed, O man, who are you to reply against God? Will the thing formed say to him who formed it, 'Why have you made me like this?'" (Romans 9:20)

Jesus reaffirmed Creation when He said:

tonight? Bring them out to us that we may know them carnally." (Genesis 19:4-5)

4) Hundreds of years later, God's People, Judah, were reminded of their shameless sins because

The look on their countenance witnesses against them, And they declare their sin as Sodom; They do not hide it. Woe to their soul! For they have brought evil upon themselves. (**Isaiah 3:9**)

5) Christians should be ashamed of shameful sins.

And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them. For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret. But all things that are exposed are made manifest by the light, for whatever makes manifest is light" (Ephesians 5:11-13).

Christians will stand up for God's Word, speak out with its light, and separate themselves from the shameful, secret sins of others.

6) Because God "desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4), He "now commands all men everywhere to repent" (Acts 17:30). LGBTQ needs forgiveness, not acceptance!
