**Planned Parenthood, or Murder?**

God has always condemned Government slaughter of babies:

God brought withering war against Syria (**Amos 1:3-5**) because Hazael's plan was to kill all babies before birth!
3. **Herod's slaughter of all male children, aged 2 years old and under**, in Bethlehem (**Matthew 2:13-22**), led to his death shortly thereafter.

**Against Nature**

According to **Romans 1:22-25**, when people worship and serve the Creation instead of the Creator, as in the idolatrous doctrine of Evolution, they have "uncleanness in the lusts of their hearts, to dishonor their bodies among themselves." When people have "exchanged the truth of God for the lie" (**Romans 1:25**), they abandon God's rules for what is "natural."

For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature. Likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust for one another, men with men committing what is shameful, and receiving in themselves the penalty of their error which was due. (**Romans 1:26-27**)

**Missing Fathers Days**

"Father's Day" began with memorial service held in 1908 for a large group of men, many of them fathers, who were killed in a mining accident in Monongah, West Virginia in December 1907. According to the website [timeanddate.com](http://timeanddate.com) :

Father's Day is an occasion to mark and celebrate the contribution that your own father has made to your life.
