## 3/13/2023 Why Were Scriptures Written?

Inasmuch as many have taken in hand to set in order a narrative of those things which have been fulfilled among us, just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word delivered them to us, it seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write to you an orderly account, most excellent Theophilus, that you may know the certainty of those things in which you were instructed. (Luke 1:1-4)

- 1.Luke's "orderly account" would make certain what Theophilus had only heard (i.e. "oral traditions," or "gossip");
- 2. This written Scripture completes the "word delivered;"
- 3. This "orderly account" was to certify truth distinguished from "many" other narratives;
- 4. "Certainty" of faith came from sure, written "scripture" and not from any other source!

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## 3/14/2023 Roman Catholic Church Has Not Spirit

But when they deliver you up, do not worry about how or what you should speak. For it will be given to you in that hour what you should speak; for it is not you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father who speaks in you. (Matthew 10:19-20)

Jesus specifically said the "how," that is the wording of the revelation, and "what," that is, the message itself, should not be premeditated! The Roman Catholic Church claims "Magisterium," or continual inspiration and guidance from the Holy Spirit for its teaching office consisting of its "Pope" and Bishops. #### What Else Should He Do?

Jesus was in Jerusalem:

Then the Jews surrounded Him and said to Him, "How long do You keep us in doubt? If You are the Christ, tell us plainly."

Jesus answered them, "I told you, and you do not believe. The works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me." (John 10:24-25)

#### What doubt?

- 1. Jesus made it so plain, that when "The high priest asked Him, saying to Him, 'Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?' Jesus said, 'I am'." (Mark 14:61-62).
- 2. There were "many of the people [who] believed in Him, and said, 'When the Christ comes, will He do more signs than these which this Man has done?'" (John 7:31).

No one who ever lived has claimed what Jesus claimed and proven it with the power He did!

The Rule for Civilization

The Wisdom of God speaks:

The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate. Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom; I am understanding, I have strength. By me kings reign, And rulers decree justice. By me princes rule, and nobles, All the judges of the earth. (Proverbs 8:13-16)

When Is Jesus' Second Coming?

They would "see Jerusalem surrounded by armies" (Luke 21:20)

[Jesus said:] "Assuredly, I say to you, this generation will by no means pass away till all things take place." (Mark 13:30)

[Of the Second Coming, Jesus said,] "But of that day and hour no one knows." (Mark 13:32)

Those who preach those "signs" as if they precede the Second Coming of Christ have ignored what Jesus actually said, and have shown complete disregard for the Word of God.

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
